Stratum: a practical, compact homelift

At Stannah we have been providing lifts for generations, in fact for over 150 years. Since those early days we have been constantly innovating to help make our customers' lives that little bit easier.

Our Stratum lift combines tried and trusted lift technology with total practicality to provide a range of lifts to suit all needs.

Available with both half-height and fully enclosed cabins the Stratum is a surprisingly affordable addition to the home. The Stratum range comes in nine different cabin shapes and sizes accommodating a seated user in our smallest offering, to three people standing or wheelchair user and attendant at the largest end of the scale.

Whether it is taking you smoothly and quietly up to bed at night or helping you take the laundry up and down, the Stratum will make your life easier.

Affordable practicality

The genius of modern compact homelifts is the fact they are self-supporting, meaning they can be installed almost anywhere in the home without the need for extensive structural work.

The Stratum is supported by two heavy duty vertical steel guides that attach to the ground floor, midway to the floor joists and finally to the ceiling on the upper floor.

We've taken care to ensure the workings of the lift are hidden so that it looks neat and tidy in your home. Being hydraulically powered means that the pump for the lift can be located up to 10 metres away, minimising any noise and giving a smooth, vibration-free ride. Without any bulky machinery on top of the lift car, the Stratum can make maximum use of headroom on the upper floor.


Low level access into the lift means there is no requirement to create a pit on the ground floor for easy access, leaving you free to enjoy the space when your lift is parked upstairs.


Our pressure sensitive edges on both the top and the bottom of the car ensure the lift stops in the event of an obstruction and our fully compliant fire seal gives delivers fire protection whether the lift is upstairs or down.






Flexible room placement






Luxury designed for everyday life

- Various cabin sizes available with half height or fully enclosed cabin
- Safety edges edges on the top and the bottom of the lift car to prevent the lift from moving in the event of an obstruction
- Fire seal the BS5900:2012 compliant fire seal around the aperture created in the ceiling/floor delivers smoke and fire protection, whether the lift is in the upper or lower position
- Made from powder coated steel for a quality feel and durability
- Wireless wall controls makes calling the lift between floors easy
- Door lock automatically locks during travel for complete safety. In the case of both mains and battery power failure, the door has a manual release facility
- Self supporting structure vertical steel guides, which not only guide the lift car but also conceal the hydraulic ram, only fixed at ground, middle and upper level allowing maximum flexibility in positioning a lift in your home
- Shallow ramps all our lifts offer low level access at the ground floor with no need for an unsightly pit and level access at first floor level
- Battery back up allows the lift to return safely to the ground floor in the event of a power cut
- Speed BS5900:2012 regulates homelift travel to 0.06m per second
- Compliance the Stratum homelift is fully compliant to BS5900:2012

Stratum fully enclosed - standard features

As standard our Stratum fully enclosed comes with the following features:

- Two lights inside the cabin
- Touch sensitive single press controls inside the cabin, easily positioned to suit each user
- Wireless wall mounted controls outside the cabin
- Powered door automatically closes and stops if obstructed
- Crystal clear toughened glass panels
- White carriage and structure
- Grey back panel with matching carpet
- Telephone (landline required for connection)
- Up to 3 metres travel
- Partial battery back up allows lift to work in downward direction in the event of a power cut

- Two lights inside the cabin
- Touch sensitive controls inside the cabin, easily positioned to suit each user (fixed in compact seated model)
- Powered door (on all models except the compact seated model)
- Wireless wall mounted controls outside the cabin
- Crystal clear glass panels
- White powder coated carriage and structure
- Up to 3 metres travel
- Partial battery back up allows lift to work in downward direction in the event of a power cut








These days installing a homelift is a relatively quick and simple operation taking just a few days from start to finish.

We will take care of all the preparation work for you, using our network of approved subcontractors. A dedicated contact in our office will manage the whole process and keep you informed every step of the way. A building notice is required in order to install a homelift and we'll also coordinate this for you right through to gaining a completion certificate. Our fire safety rating is fully compliant so the process is very straightforward.

Working from the full survey we prepare, preparation work takes just a day or two and involves creating an aperture in the ceiling /floor to allow the lift to pass through. Depending on the property we may need to undertake some other tasks such as rerouting cabling or pipework.

Once the preparation work is completed installation can take place and usually takes just a couple of days. Our NVQ-qualified installers will work diligently to deliver a first-class installation and will give you a detailed handover to ensure you are confident in how your lift operates before they leave you to enjoy the luxury of a lift in your home.

Once your lift is installed we want you to get the best out of it, so we are here to make sure it continues to run like clockwork for many, many years to come.

Frequently asked questions

How does a Stratum work?

All our homelifts use quiet, clean hydraulic drives that have safety inbuilt. Fluid is pushed through a ram which pushes the lift up and released to lower the lift.

How many floors can a Stratum travel?

A Stratum is perfect for travel between two storeys/floors.

How many people can it carry?

Lifts in the Stratum range can take 1 person seated, up to three people standing, a wheelchair user or wheelchair user and attendant.

Can a Stratum take a wheelchair?

The Stratum range is ideal for wheelchair users with a range of sizes to choose from.

Will my walls be strong enough?

Our compact lifts have their own selfsupporting structures so do not require any supporting walls.

Will there be a step into the lift?

Our Stratum offers low level access without having to create an unsightly pit on the ground floor.

Is the Stratum noisy?

No, the Stratum is very quiet and hydraulic lifts offer the added benefit that the pump unit can be located up to 10m away, even outside so further minimising noise. Note the pump only engages in the upward direction so downward travel is particularly quiet.

Are homelifts safe?

Homelifts are of course substantial pieces of machinery in the home but are extremely safe when used properly. Our compact lifts all come with a range of safety features to ensure peace of mind.

What if there is a power cut?

In the event of a loss of mains power, both battery backup and a manual system is included to allow you to lower your lift to the ground floor.

Do I need a building permit?

You will definitely need a building permit but we will arrange that for you.

Do I need an architect or builder?

A Stratum homelift requires minimal structural work and we will make all of the necessary arrangements required for you. However, if you are already working with a builder or architect, we will happily collaborate with them.

How often does my lift need servicing?

A Stratum requires an annual service to keep it running at its best.

Once you have made the decision to go ahead and order you just need to give us a quick call and we'll get everything moving.

Step 4:

We'll arrange for a full survey to be done to ensure a structurally sound installation.

Step 5:
