How to use your Siena or Starla

Using your stairlift couldn't be simpler. Your installer will give you a full demonstration after it's been fitted, but here's a simple guide.



- 1 Unfold the arms and seat to get started. The Siena has a lever to lower the footrest, while the Starla does the work for you - simply press the button.



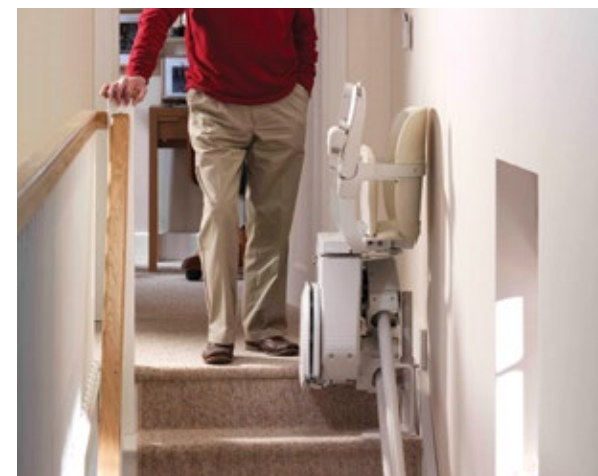
- 2 Are you sitting comfortably? Then we'll begin. Just lower the arms, fasten the easy-reach seatbelt and you're ready to go.



- 3 A gentle touch of the control is all it takes to get moving.



- 4 You've arrived at your destination! Just use your lever or powered swivel to easy-turn onto your landing, ready to step off safely.



- 5 Not using your stairlift? No problem. Leave it as it is, or fold it down so people can simply walk past it on the stairs.

Sadler

We've designed the Sadler stairlift specifically for those with limited flexibility, particularly anyone with knee or hip issues. It's a brand new take on stairlift design, engineered to give you the freedom to move upstairs effortlessly, all while maintaining a comfortable, upright posture.

The Sadler's tilted seat reduces strain on your joints by supporting much of your weight, so you can glide up and down your staircase with minimal pressure on your knees and hips. Six seat height options mean you're always comfortably supported, and its slim profile makes it perfect for curved staircases, no matter how narrow.

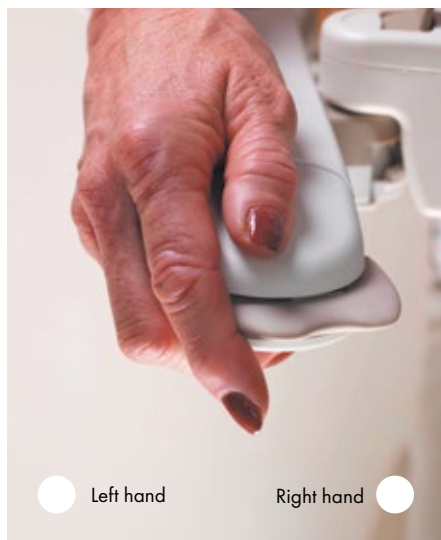

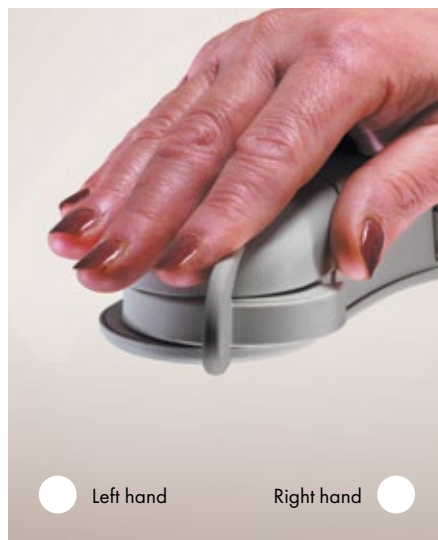

- 2 Are you sitting comfortably? Then we'll begin. Just lower the arms, fasten the easy-reach seatbelt and you're ready to go.



- 3 A gentle touch of the directional control is all it takes to get moving.



- 4 You've arrived at your destination! The Sadler's tilted seat makes it simple to get off (and on).



- 5 Not using your stairlift? No problem. Fold up the arms and the Sadler automatically folds the footrest and leaves plenty of room for others to pass safely on the stairs.

Will I need to pay for a quotation?

Not a penny. We offer a free home survey and will provide you with a no-obligation written quotation that's clear and easy to understand.

Is there a warranty?

Our new stairlifts come with a two year warranty. And our reconditioned stairlifts come with one year warranty.

What if I have narrow stairs?

Not a problem. All our stairlifts come with a slim rail and a compact carriage. They all have folding arms, seat and footrest, which fold away neatly when they are not in use.

Can Stannah stairlifts go round bends on the stairs?

Yes. Your rail will be manufactured to fit your staircase perfectly and the bespoke rails are designed specifically to cope with staircases with turns.

How long does it take to install and how disruptive is it?

Stannah stairlifts are usually installed in just a couple of hours and with the minimum of fuss. Our engineers will leave your home in exactly the same condition they found it – with the addition of a lovely new stairlift of course!

Will my stairlift be noisy?

No. Stannah stairlifts are very quiet as they have a battery-powered motor, which also ensures a smooth and comfortable ride on your staircase.

How fast does the stairlift travel?

All our stairlifts move at 0.1 metre per second. The average stairlift length we install is 5.5 metres, so it takes 55 seconds to travel one way.

How much does a stairlift cost to run?

A Stannah stairlift costs around £20 in electricity per year to run, about 40p per week. Less than a kettle!
